

LOCATION

You will be in one of the most iconic places for a safari. Campi ya Kanzi is just 35 miles away from 19,341 ft Kilimanjaro, resting on the foothills of the Chyulu Hills (Hemingway's Green Hills of Africa). Lions, elephants, buffaloes, giraffes and all types of antelopes populate the area. This is a place you do not want to miss on your safari!






HOW TO GET THERE

Our airplane (Cessna 206) or by charter, 1 hour flight from Nairobi (or Mombasa, or Malindi) - 30 minutes from Tanzania (Namanga).

ACCOMODATION




































PERSONAL HOSTING


ITINERARIES

We tailor activities to suit each guest's requirements. We recommend a 3 to 4 nights stay at Campi ya Kanzi and 2 to 3 nights stay at Chyulu Lodge to fully enjoy the ecosystem and explore the rich biodiversity of the area. The connection with the local Maasai landlords is not just profound, but extremely genuine.

As the conservation fee per guest per day is paid to the Maasai Wilderness Conservation Trust, guests are seen as benefactors. Walking in the savannah, in the clouds forest, along the river, with a Maasai tracker is an unforgettable experience. Wildlife diversity is extremely rich and landscape beauty impressive. Tsavo, largest National Park in Kenya, is magnificent, and Amboseli, with elephants and flamingoes is iconic.




CLIMATE

Temperatures are very comfortable year-round, with daytime highs around 95F/35C and night time lows around 65F/17C. The coolest month is July, with January and February being the warmest. During and just after the short rains of November and April/May, the area is particularly beautiful, everything is green and Kilimanjaro is covered with snow.

During this period the elephant population is at its peak.
